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Canadian Muslim Community Mourns the Loss of Innocent Lives in Egypt Mosque Terror Attack

Ahmadiyya Muslim Jama'at Canada condemns terror attack in Egypt

It is reported that attackers planted explosives and then opened fire on worshippers, killing at least 235 people and leaving more than 109 others injured.

"It is horrifying that an attack of this nature would occur – especially at a mosque where peaceful worshippers were gathered to offer prayers."
